## Summary of Daily Tour Activities

### Day 5 JORDAN VALLEY / DEAD SEA / EIN GEDI / LEISURE AFTERNOON

This morning, we say good-bye to the Galilee and begin our journey south through the Jordan Valley. Stop at the shores of the Dead Sea, lowest spot on earth, where those who desire may take a quick dip in its unique waters. Journey to the oasis of Ein Gedi, where David and his men sought refuge from Saul (1 Samuel 23). Leisure time on your own this afternoon to relax or explore. Enjoy dinner and overnight in our Dead Sea hotel.

### Day 6 JUDEAN WILDERNESS / TEMPLE MOUNT / ANTONIA FORTRESS / POOL OF BETHESDA / SHRINE OF THE BOOK – MODEL CITY / SHOPPING

Travel the road from Jericho to Jerusalem that twists for miles as it climbs from below sea level into the Judean mountains. See the Temple Mount, once the site of the Temple of Solomon and Herod. Visit the Southern Wall Excavations of the ancient Temple including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. Walk through the remains of Herod's Antonia Fortress where it is believed that Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke



23). View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Next visit the remarkable Model of Jerusalem as it was laid out during the Roman occupation. Viewing this model will help us understand what the city looked like during the time of Christ. Wander the Shrine of the Book, home of some of the Dead Sea scrolls. Shopping this evening for those who desire.

**Day 7 MT. OF OLIVES / PALM SUNDAY ROAD / GETHSEMANE / VIA DOLOROSA / CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHER / OLD CITY SHOPPING**

Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the top of the Mount of Olives (Acts 1). Visit the Chapel of the Ascension. Walk the Palm Sunday Road, down the Mt. of Olives. Stopping en-route at Dominus Fleuit Church, a great view and excellent place to sing. Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross", and stand in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. This afternoon enjoy free time on your own to explore the Old City.

**Day 8 UPPER ROOM / WESTERN WALL / RABBI'S TUNNEL / GARDEN TOMB / GORDON'S CALVARY / EVENING MESSIANIC SERVICE**

Visit Mount Zion and the Upper Room, possible site of the Last Supper of Jesus and His disciples. The Temple Museum houses an array of implements that are planned to be used in the next Temple. Take time to pray at the Western Wall and step back in time as we walk through the Rabbi's Tunnel, seeing huge stones that were set in place to support the temple complex over 2000 years ago. Take time to reflect at the Garden Tomb, celebrating the exhilaration of the resurrection of our Lord, followed by our remembrance of the agony of the cross at Gordon's Calvary. This evening take part in a local Messianic service.

**Day 9 POOL OF SILOAM / SAMUEL'S TOMB / JUDEAN HILLS / EMMAUS / VALLEY OF ELAH / JOPPA / TEL AVIV**

Celebrate your last morning in Israel with a Prayer, Praise and Prophetic Service before heading out for a day of sightseeing. Stand on the steps of the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9). Travel through the Judean Hills to arrive at the ruins of Emmaus where Jesus, after His resurrection, met two of His disciples who did not recognize Him until He later broke bread with them that evening (Luke 24). Journey through the Valley of Elah where David defeated Goliath (I Samuel 17). Return to Jerusalem for dinner and transfer to the airport for our flight back to the US.

**Day 10 ARRIVE USA**

Today we arrive back in the United States with a lifetime of memories to cherish. Meals Served in flight.
